Primary Map to Scale

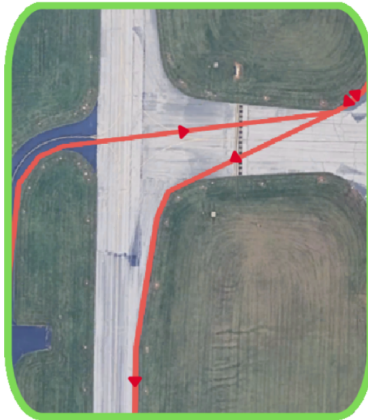
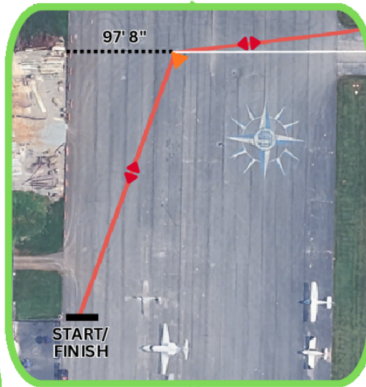

START/FINISH: Directly parallel to the northern most corner light post of the Pryor FBO. Mandatory routing point along taxiway center line 97' 8" from west most curb

MILE 1: 4' N of the taxiway light directly across from the FTAir building

Mandatory Routing Points: At the corner of the "pink" concrete and asphalt northeast of the Southern Hanger and the corner of the "pink" concrete and asphalt at the northeast end of the section of airplane hangers

MILE 2: At the intersection of the asphalt and historical pink concrete surface

MILE 3: 25' N of the S intersection point of the taxiway centerlines of the E/W taxiway and N/S taxiway

▲ - denotes mandatory routing points to maintain course distance in instances where a shorter route than measured is possible.
