

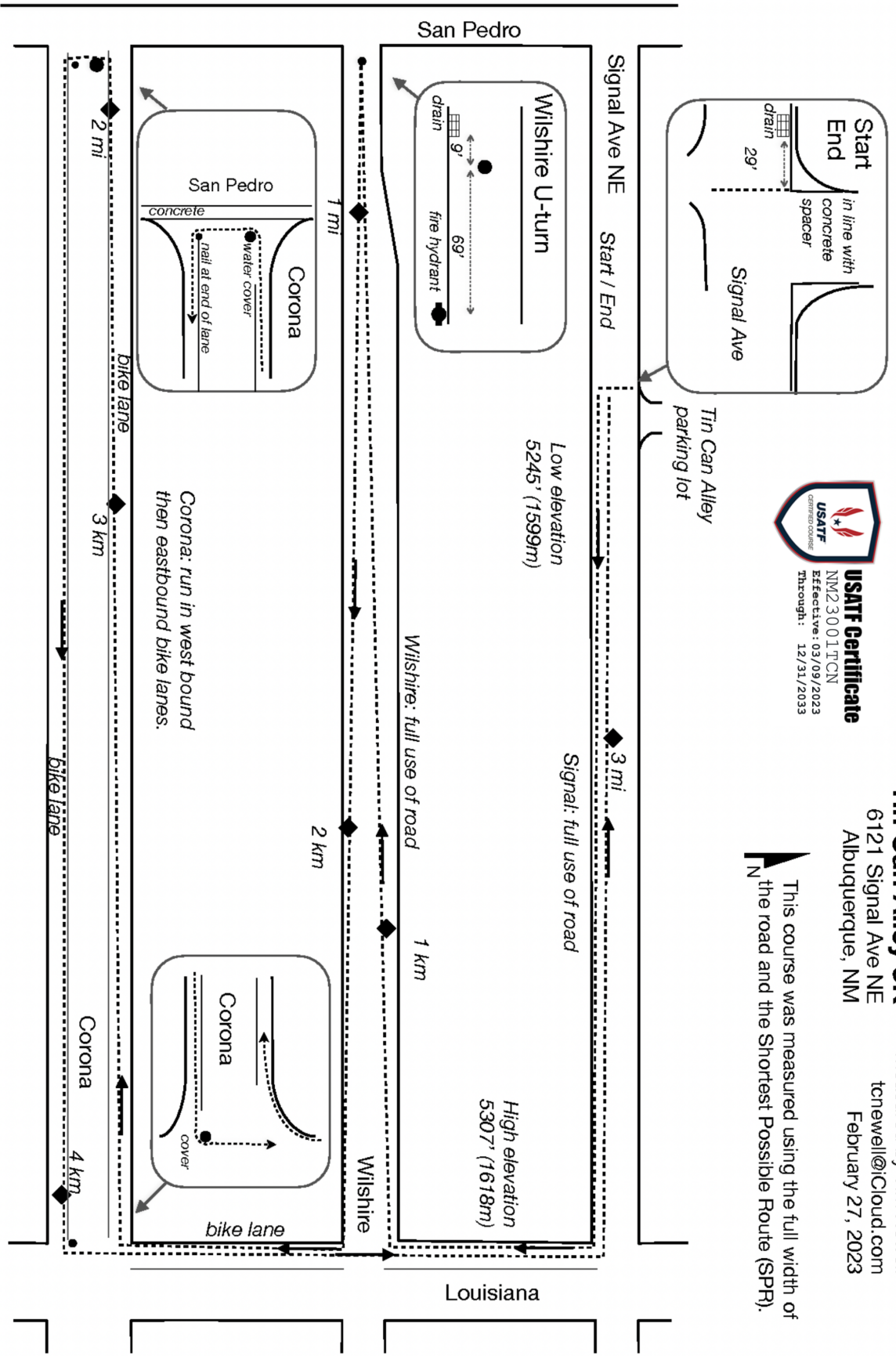

START / END: West edge of driveway for Tin Can Alley Parking in line with the concrete driveway edge.

1 km: Wilshire east of Rancho Mirage; 62 feet west of water cover at Sentido St.

2 km: Wilshire west of Rancho Mirage; 60 feet west of fire hydrant

3 km: 6502 Corona center of driveway adjacent to water cover.

4 km: 115 feet west of stop sign at Louisiana

Mile 1: Wilshire 38 feet east of the water cover at 6205 Wilshire (after Wilshire U-Turn)

Mile 2: Corona Middle of the assisted living facility driveway, across from 6404 Corona (before U-turn.)

Mile 3: Signal west of Campo Norte Way. 24 feet west of the center of road water cover

Wilshire U-Turn: 9 feet west of drain on south side of road at San Pedro.

Corona U-Turn: Water cover adjacent to the stop sign for San Pedro. Go around the water cover, cross road to the bike lane then turn east in the bike lane.
