

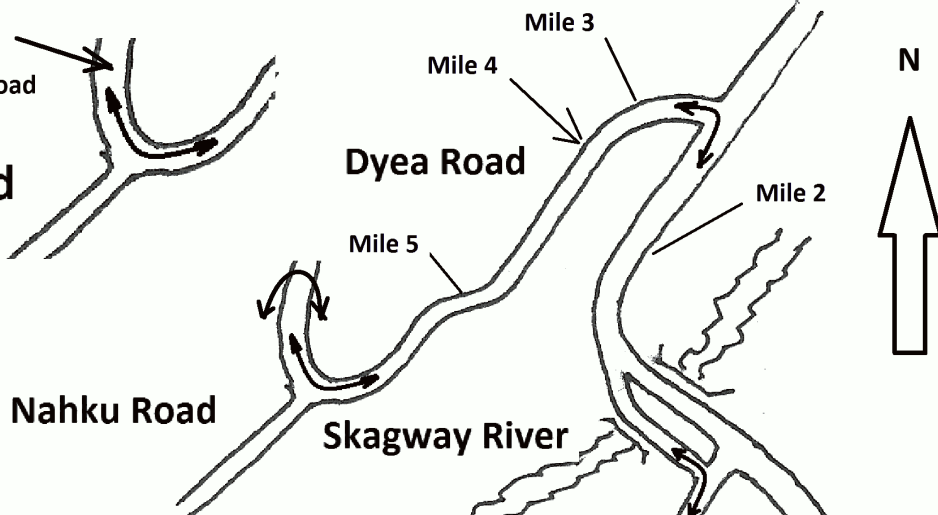

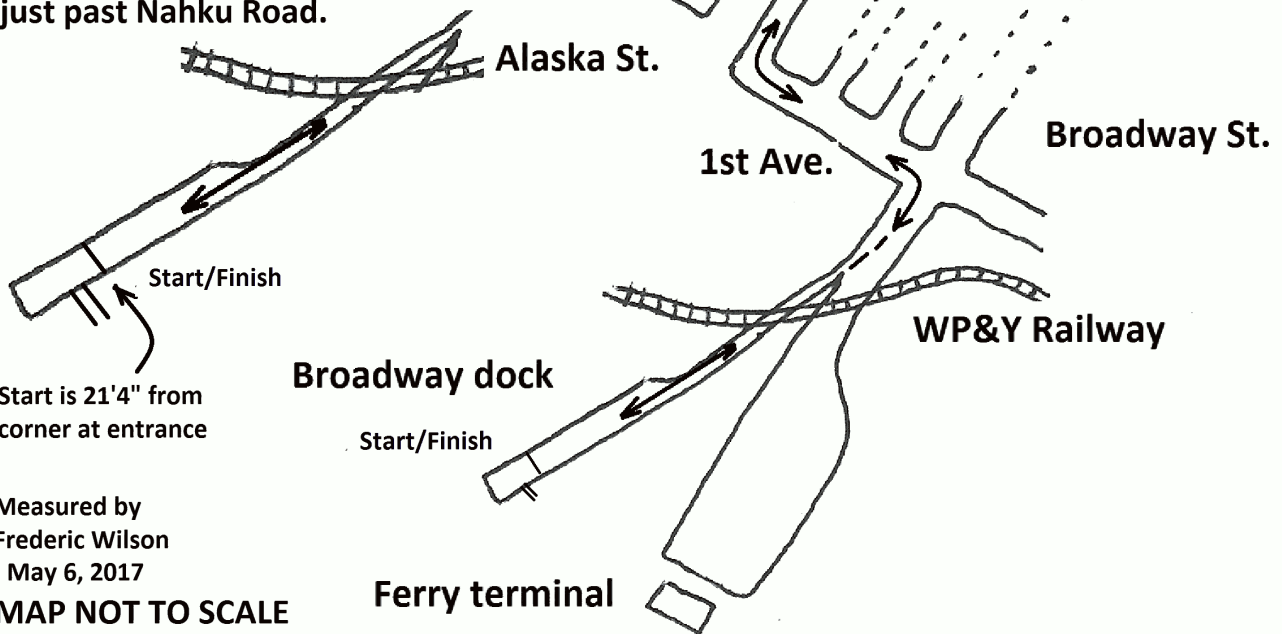
Klondike Highway
