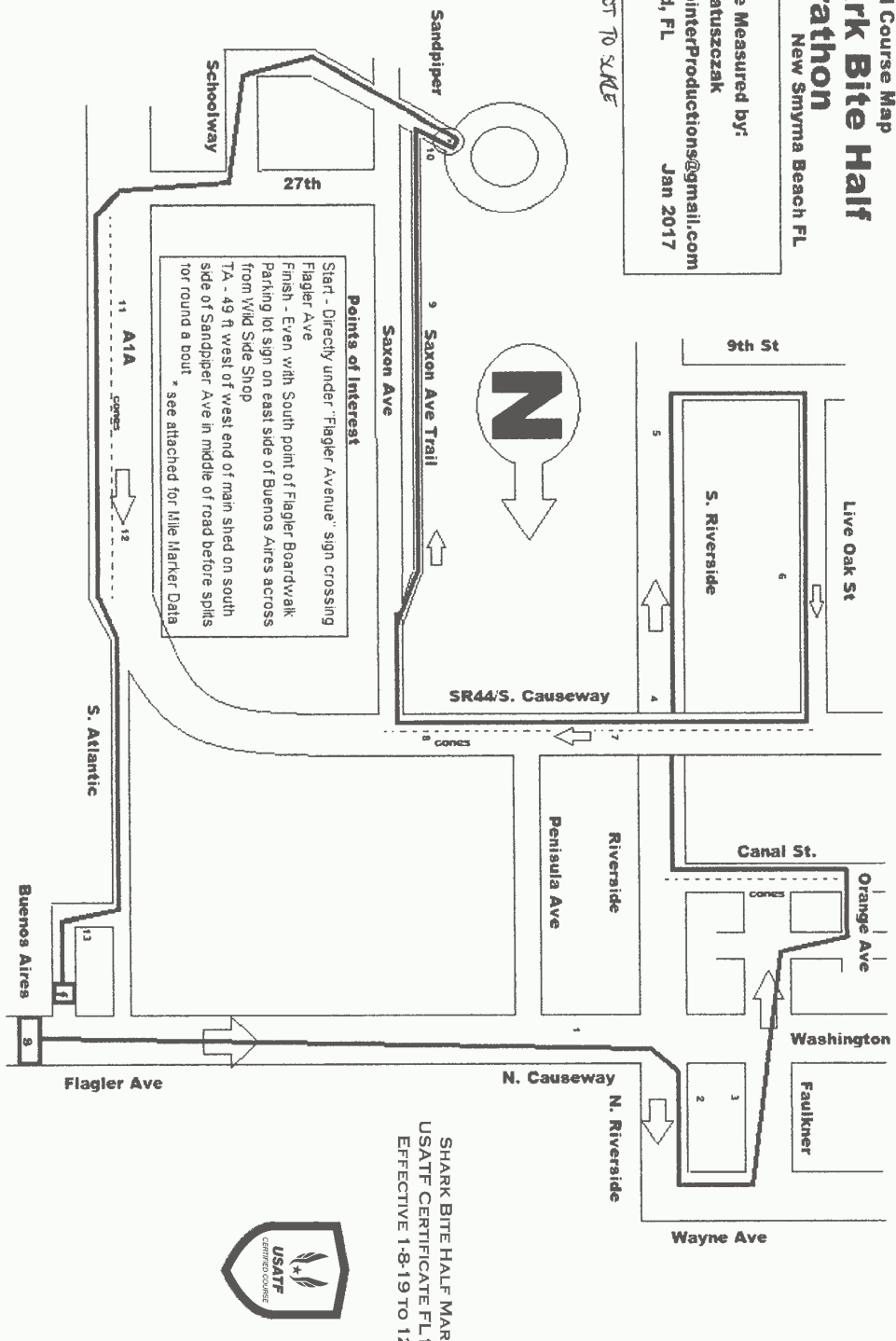

## Official Course Map Points of Interest

Start – Directly Under “Flagler Avenue” sign crossing the road at the beach approach.

Mile 1 – 5’ West of TP:UC2698 on N. Causeway

Mile 2 – 24’10” North of TP:UC2892. At Intersection of Mary & N. Riverside

Mile 3 – 88’10” South of TP:UC2908 at Murray & Faulkner

Mile 4 – 58’ North of TP:UC6578. Just south of S. Causeway

Mile 5 – 28’6” South of TP:UC6887. Between 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> St

Mile 6 – 50’ South of TP:UC6797. Just South of Live Oak & 3<sup>rd</sup> St

Mile 7 – 101’6” West of eastern most point of cement wall plus railing on the southside of S. Causeway bridge heading east bound.

Mile 8 – 72’4” East of TP at the West side of driveway to Mon Delice Deli (TP did not have number)

Mile 9 – 56’6” North of LP: UC3390 on Saxon Ave Pedestrian Trail near Saxon & 15<sup>th</sup> St

Mile 10 – 3’9” East of TP:UC1418 on South side of Sandpiper. Near first entrance to Coronado Cove development.

Turn Around – 49’ West of the west end of main shed (going into Indian River Park on left) in the middle of the road before the road splits for round a bout.

Mile 11 – 17’ South of TP:12800572-S in front of Chases Restaurant.

Mile 12 – 127’8” South of TP:UC1366 located at the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> & A1A

Mile 13 – 33’10” South of TP:C1434 in front of Toni & Joe’s Restaurant.

Finish – Even with Southern most point of “Flagler Boardwalk Parking Lot Sign” on east side of Buenos Aires directly across from Wild Side Shop.

### Cones on Course

- Cone off Canal Street from Orange Ave to Riverside. Keeping participants in the Eastbound Lane
- Cone off breakdown Lane on SR44/A1A from Live Oak to Saxon
- Cone off most east lane of A1A from 27<sup>th</sup> St to S. Atlantic fork. Keeping participants in the furthest east Northbound lane.
