

St. Patrick's 10k Walk/Run
 Minneapolis, Minnesota
 First run March 16, 2003

Course:

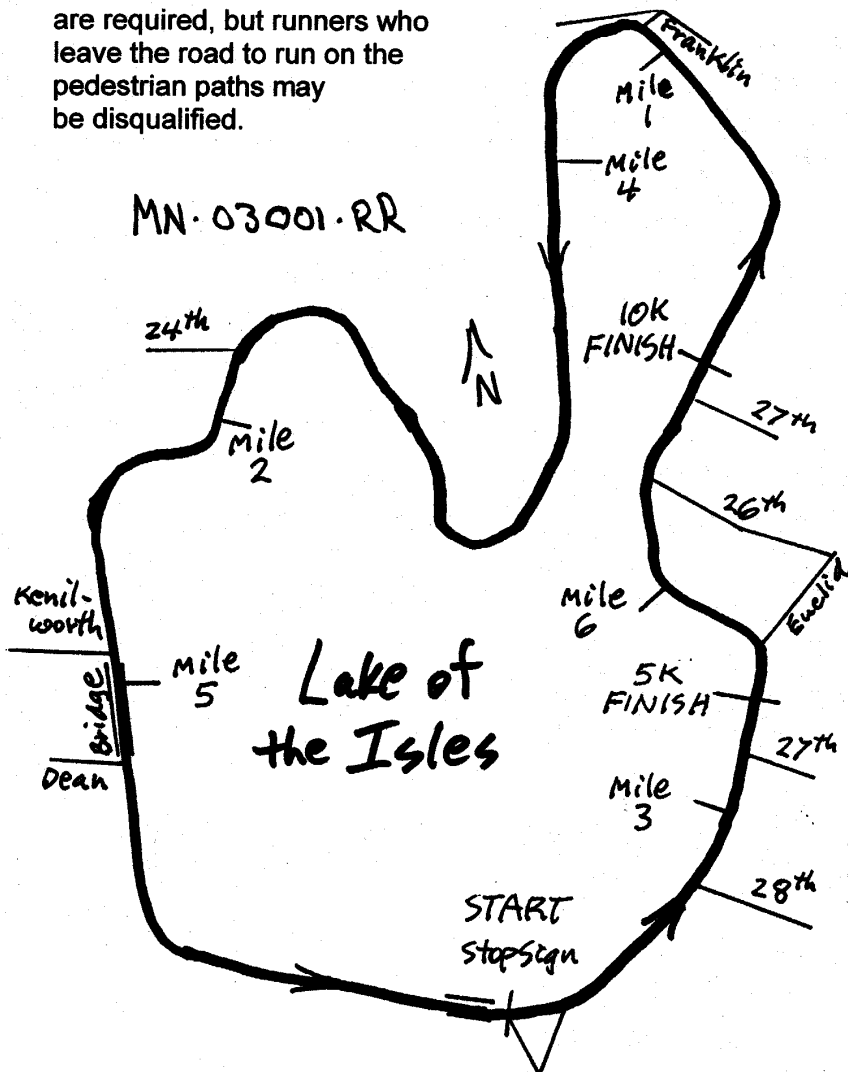
Start at the stop sign on the bridge at the south end of Lake of the Isles (South Knox Avenue). Twice around plus, going counter-clockwise on Lake of the Isles Parkway, not the pedestrian paths. The Parkway is a one-way road going the same direction as the race.

Map is not to scale. Road has more curves and intersections than shown. Course was measured along the shortest route that a runner could take while staying on the road or in the gutter.

No cones or other restrictions are required, but runners who leave the road to run on the pedestrian paths may be disqualified.

Measured Points:

- Start Stop sign on bridge at south end of lake, at S Knox Av.
- Mile 1 20 ft (6 m) S of southernmost of three storm drains on left side of road just S of jct w Franklin.
- Mile 2 Even w SW edge of driveway 2442 W Lake Isles Parkway.
- Mile 3 10 ft (3 m) S of S edge of sidewalk 2727 E Lake Isles Parkway.
- 5K Center of large tree centered between driveways 2681 & 2683 E Lake Isles Parkway.
- Mile 4 6 ft (2 m) S of S edge of sidewalk W Lake Isles Parkway.
- Mile 5 On bridge between Kenilworth and Dean, left side, 18th guard rail post from Kenilworth side.
- Mile 6 Property line between 2631 and 2637 E Lake Isles Pky (retaining walls meet).
- Finish 10 ft (3 m) N of N edge of sidewalk 2419 E Lake Isles Parkway.



5k point and 10k finish are marked with 3" painted yellow dots on pavement. Painted marks were made in wet conditions and may not be present at race time.
