

START: On the North side of Bienville Ave., 61' West of the end of the curbing for the entrance to the Marine Sciences Hall, also 25' East of the No Parking sign on Bienville. Marked with green paint and two washers.

MILE 1: On the North side of Bienville, between Buchanan and Forney Johnson Streets. 75' West of the big Circuit Breaker on the North side of the road and East of the East driveway to Residence #406. Marked with green paint and two washers.

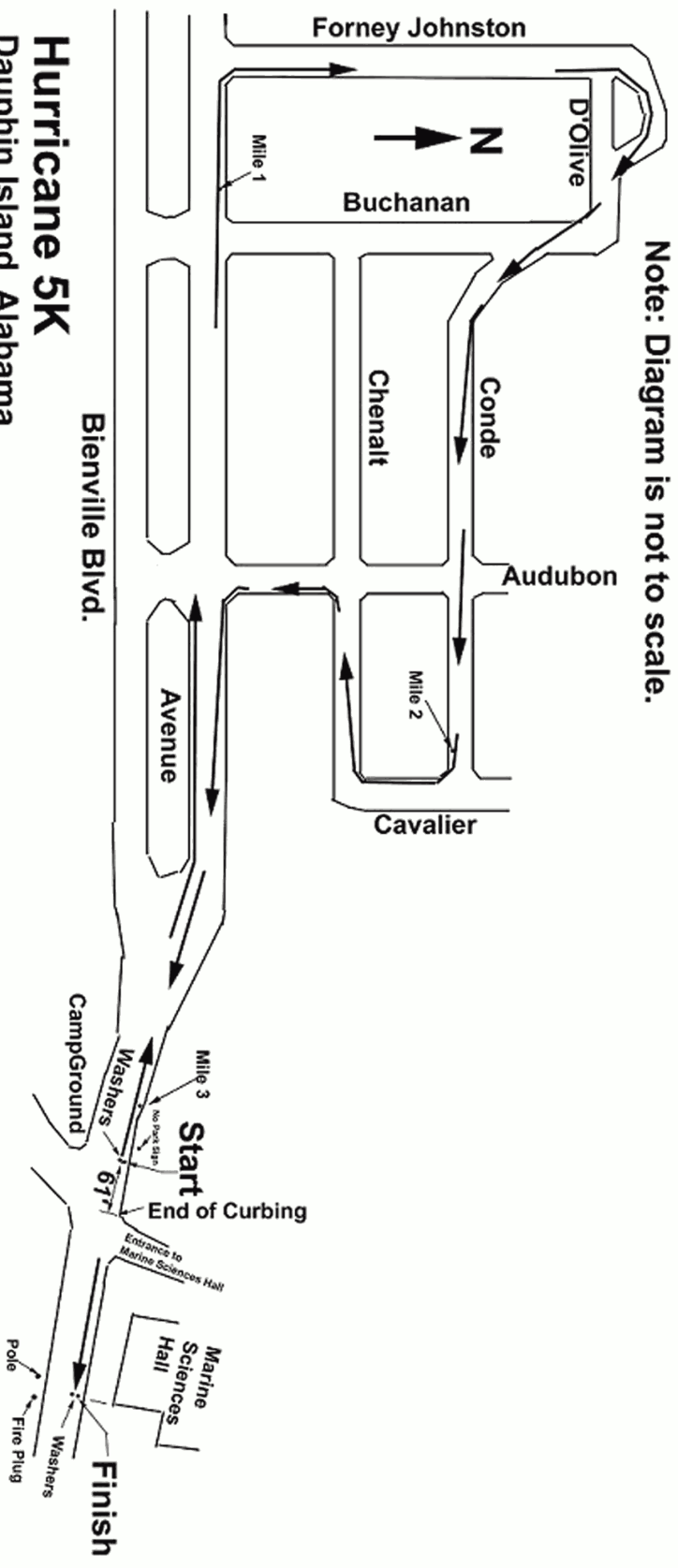
MILE 2: On Conde Ave., 95' West of the intersection Conde Ave and Cavalier. Marked with green paint and two washers.

MILE 3: 24' South of North Pedestrian Walkway to Magnolia Park. Marked with green paint and two washers.

FINISH: On the North edge of Bienville Ave., in line with East wall of the MSH building. Also 6' east of power pole and 8' West of the fire hydrant, both on the south side of the road. Marked with green paint and two washers.
