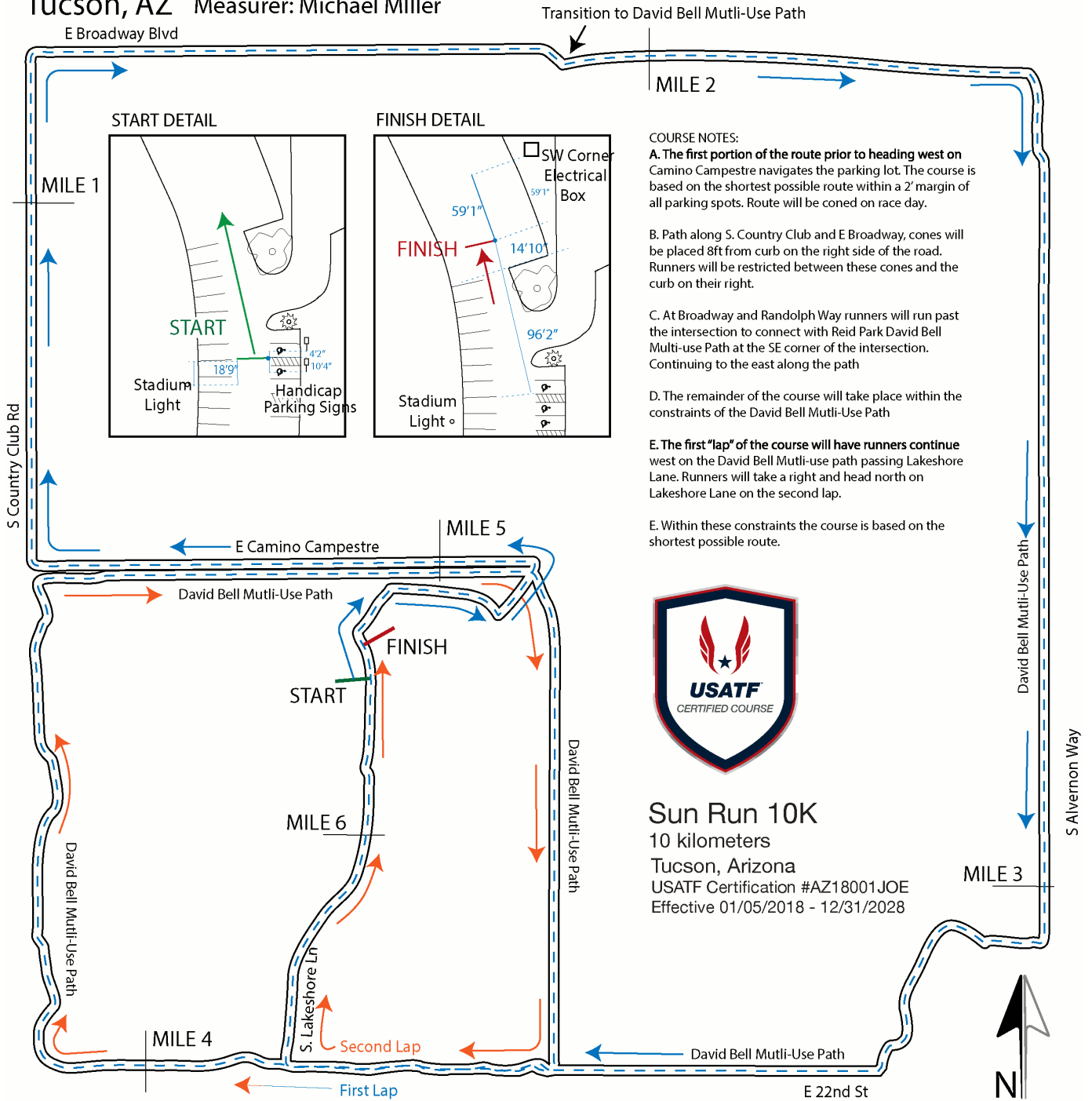


SUN RUN 10k

Tucson, AZ Measurer: Michael Miller



COURSE NOTES:

A. The first portion of the route prior to heading west on Camino Campestre navigates the parking lot. The course is based on the shortest possible route within a 2' margin of all parking spots. Route will be coned on race day.

B. Path along S. Country Club and E Broadway, cones will be placed 8ft from curb on the right side of the road. Runners will be restricted between these cones and the curb on their right.

C. At Broadway and Randolph Way runners will run past the intersection to connect with Reid Park David Bell Multi-use Path at the SE corner of the intersection. Continuing to the east along the path

D. The remainder of the course will take place within the constraints of the David Bell Multi-Use Path

E. The first "lap" of the course will have runners continue west on the David Bell Multi-use path passing Lakeshore Lane. Runners will take a right and head north on Lakeshore Lane on the second lap.

E. Within these constraints the course is based on the shortest possible route.

COURSE MARKERS

<p>START: The start line is 4'2" South of the base of the north most handicapped parking sign and 18'4" north of the second sign, measured along the east curb line, also north of the stadium light 18'9" measured along the west curb line.</p> <p>MILE 1: 12'2" to the west of the apex of the second from the north circular brick wall and 138'6" south of the stop sign at the intersection of Country Club and Via Palos Verdes.</p> <p>MILE 2: 80'4" west of the north most pole of the Golf Course Billboard and 55'9" the east of the base of the "Welcome to the David Bell Mutli-Use Path" sign.</p> <p>MILE 3: 21'0" south of end of the light post at 903 S Alvernon Way and 143'7" north of the light post at 930 S Alvernon Way</p>	<p>MILE 4: 40'8" to the west of light post at 3201 E 22nd St and 80'1" east of the light post at 3173 E 22nd St</p> <p>MILE 5: On ramp west of Luna Linda & Camino Campestre, 4'11" east of the beginning of the curb and 7'7" west of the transition from concrete to asphalt</p> <p>MILE 6: 6" south of crosswalk/stop/railroad crossing sign, 35'1" south of the termination of the curb and 20'4" north of the speed bump.</p> <p>FINISH: Finish is 96'2" north of the start and 14'10" from the end of the curb, both measured along the east curb line. The finish line is 59'1" south of the SW Corner of Electrical Box, also measured along the east curb line.</p>
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Mile marks, start and finish are marked with nails and yellow paint
