

Chickamauga Chase 15k Chickamauga, GA

Each mile, halfway, the Start and the Finish are all marked with two single washers, one on each side of the road. Do *not* confuse these marks with the Marathon mile markers, which are marked with two washers on each side of the road.

The runners have full use of the paved roadway, from one edge of the pavement to the other.

Location of Mile Markers

All directions such as "before", "after", "left" and "right" are from the perspective of someone running / driving the course, in the correct direction.

Start: On Glenn-Viniard, roughly 1/10 mile ESE of the intersection with Wilder Road. Mark is exactly 255 feet ESE of the large stone culvert that allows a large creek to pass under the road. Also, 6 feet 6 inches ESE of small cedar tree (3 feet high in 2017) that sits about 9 feet off the north edge of the road.

1-mile: On Chickamauga-Vittatoe Road, less than 1/10 mile before the horse unloading area on the left. Mark is 52 feet before the metal gate, when in closed position.

2-mile: On Glenn Kelly Road, alongside the parallel parking spots on the left. Mark is 29 feet past the small stone "64th Regiment Ohio Infantry" marker that sits 21 feet off the left edge of the pavement.

3-mile: On Alexander Bridge Road, 136 feet after crossing Lafayette Road. Roughly even with the first of three parking spots on the right.

4-mile: On Alexander Bridge Road, 73 feet before the three parking spaces on the right for Ingraham's Grave.

7.5 k (halfway): On Brotherton Road, 186 feet past the small creek culvert that is immediately after passing through Winfrey Field, and 144 feet before the stone Georgia Howell's Battery monument on the right.

5-mile: On Brotherton Road, 627 feet past the wooden "Bragg's Headquarters" sign on the right, and roughly 50 feet into the first left-bending curve past that sign.

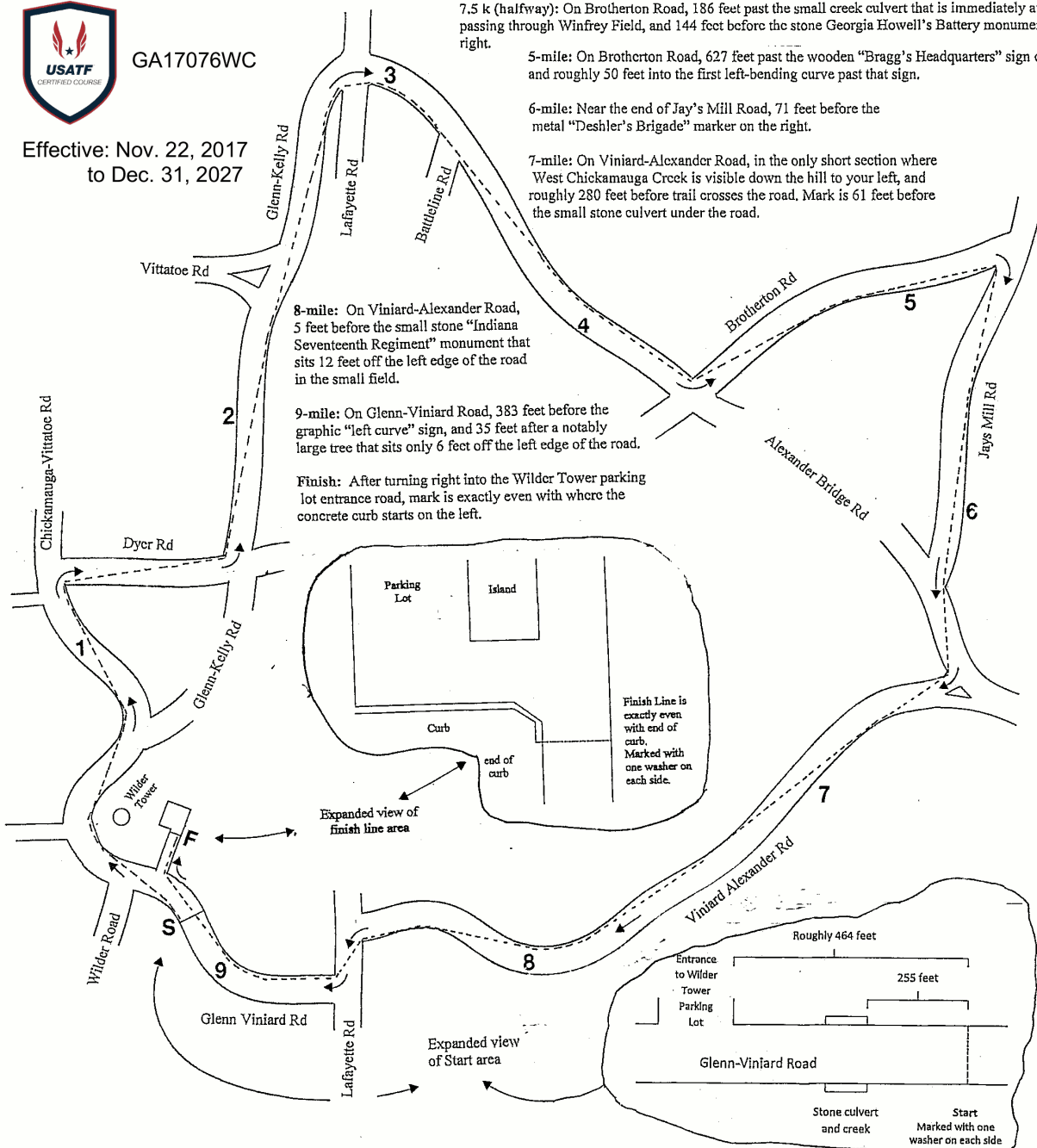
6-mile: Near the end of Jay's Mill Road, 71 feet before the metal "Deshler's Brigade" marker on the right.

7-mile: On Viniard-Alexander Road, in the only short section where West Chickamauga Creek is visible down the hill to your left, and roughly 280 feet before trail crosses the road. Mark is 61 feet before the small stone culvert under the road.

8-mile: On Viniard-Alexander Road, 5 feet before the small stone "Indiana Seventeenth Regiment" monument that sits 12 feet off the left edge of the road in the small field.

9-mile: On Glenn-Viniard Road, 383 feet before the graphic "left curve" sign, and 35 feet after a notably large tree that sits only 6 feet off the left edge of the road.

Finish: After turning right into the Wilder Tower parking lot entrance road, mark is exactly even with where the concrete curb starts on the left.
