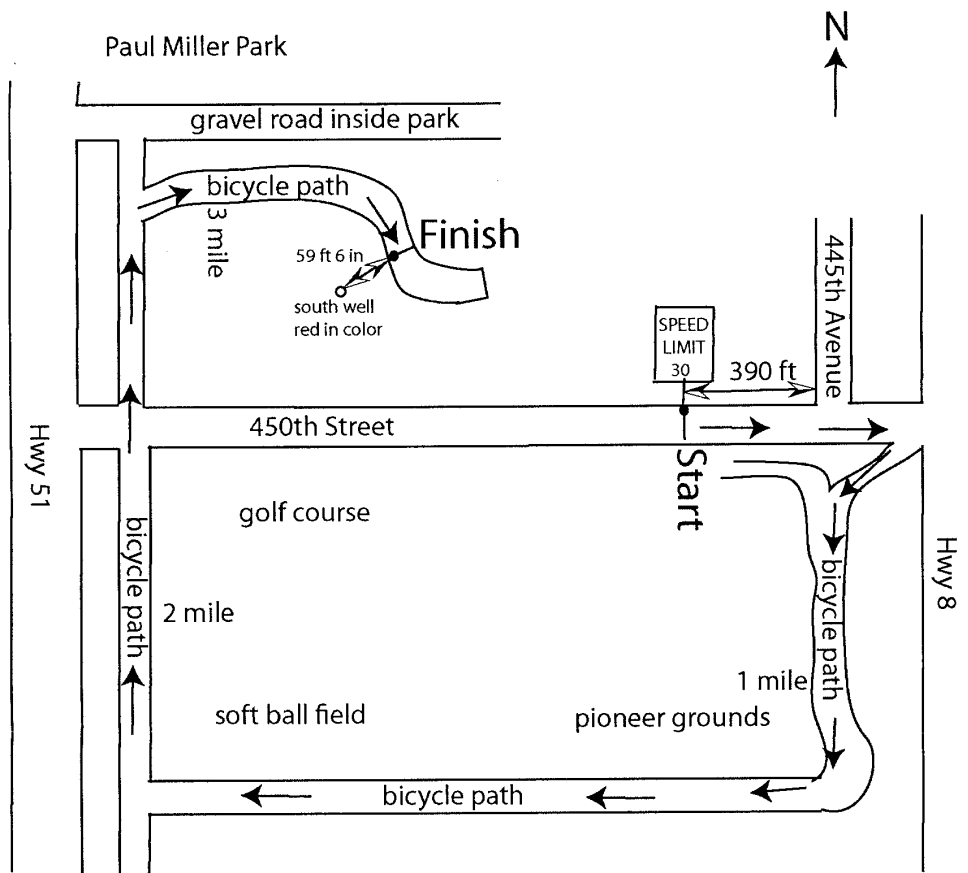


# Turtlefest 5 K

## Perham, MN

MN-09028-RR

The start is on 450th Street at the Speed Limit 30 sign and marked by a PK nail.  
 The start is about 390 feet west of 445th Avenue and between posts 13 and 14.  
 The finish is marked by a PK nail and is 59 ft 6 inches from a red well.  
 The finish is about 299 feet from the east end of the bicycle trail.



Run East from the start. Just before reaching County Hwy 8 turn right onto the bicycle path. Take this path Southwest, then South, then West. When you reach the bicycle path beside Hwy 51, run North. Cross 450th Street and continue North until you reach the uphill bicycle path in Paul Miller Park. Take this bicycle path East to the finish.
