

Pine Tree 10k White Bear Lake, MN

Effective Jul 31,2015 - Dec 31,2025

Start – on White Bear Pkwy, in front of Lifetime Fitness, 4800 White Bear Pkwy, draw a line between the green telephone junction box that is N of the Lifetime Fitness street sign, across the path/sidewalk and road to the first curb crack N of the storm drain on the W side of White Bear Pkwy. PK nail in the road at the curb crack. Start is on the road.

Finish – use the line drawn for the start, but the Finish is on the path/sidewalk on the E side of White Bear Pkwy.

Mile 1 – on the path on the N side of Hammond Rd, E of both driveways to Pentair (on S side of Hammond), E of fire hydrant on S side, E of utility pole on N side, + 9 further curb sections E (25½ m). PK nail in the path near the road.

Mile 2 – on the path to the SW from the corner of County H2 and Otter Lake Rd, 8m SW from the pole labeled "Bold Eagle Otter". PK nail on the SE edge of the path.

Turn – on the path on the N side of County H2, W of Lakeview Ave, 9m W of the street sign at the NW corner of Lakeview and H2. PK nail on the S edge of the path.

Mile 3 – on the path on the W side of Otter Tail, S of mailbox 2150, 5m N of power pole 4168. PK nail on the E edge of the path.

Mile 4 – on the path on the W side of Township Pkwy, N of rail road crossing, 13m N of park bench. PK nail on the E edge of the path.

Mile 5 – on Otter Lake Rd, 6m S of mail box 4710. PK nail on the W edge of the road (away from the mail box).

Mile 6 – on the path on the E side of White Bear Pkwy, N of 96, 11 E side wooden fence posts S of Birch Cove. PK nail on the W edge of the path.

From the **Start**, go N on White Bear Pkwy on the road
At Birch Lake Blvd, enter the bike/walk path on the W side of White Bear Pkwy

Turn N on bike/walk path on W side of Township Pkwy

Turn E on bike/walk path on N side of Hammond

Turn N on bike/walk path on W side of Otter Lake

Turn E on bike/walk path on N side of County Rd H2

At the **Turn**, turn around and go W

Turn SW onto the bike/walk path on the W side of Township Pkwy

Turn E along the N edge of White Bear Pkwy

Turn S at the crosswalk entering the bike/walk path

Turn E on bike/walk path along south side of Birch Lake Blvd

Turn S on the W edge of Otter Lake Rd

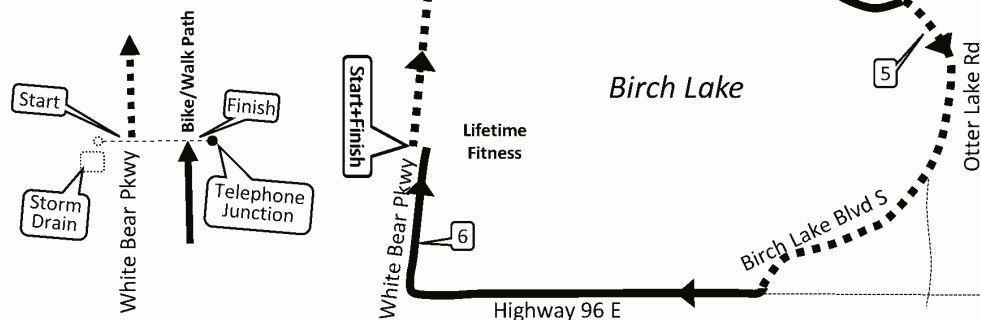
Angle right onto Birch Lake Rd (full access)

Take the short dirt path

Turn W on bike/walk path on N side of Highway 96

Turn N on bike/walk path on E side of White Bear Pkwy

Continue to **Finish**
