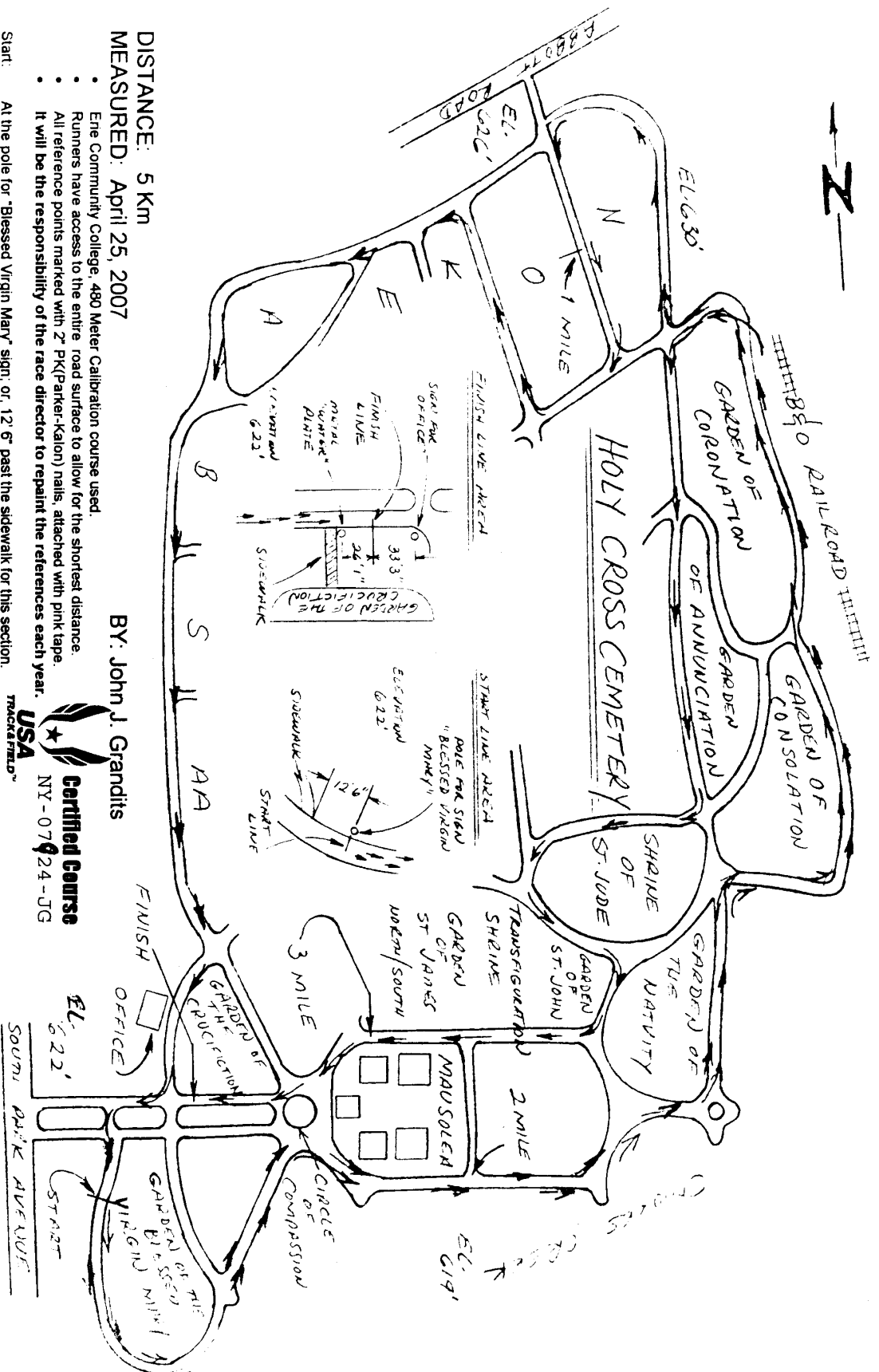

- Enne Community College, 480 Meter Calibration course used.
 - Runners have access to the entire road surface to allow for the shortest distance.
 - All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, attached with pink tape.
 - It will be the responsibility of the race director to repaint the references each year.
- At the pole for "Blessed Virgin Mary" sign, or, 12' 6" past the sidewalk for this section.
- 1 Mile: 24' 3" after the water faucet pipe on the eastern portion of Section "O".
- 2 Mile: 8' 5" before the center of the sewer grate on the road between the two mausoleum sections.
- 3 Mile: 13' 1" before the center of the doors of the northern portion of the mausoleum closest to the Circle of Compassion.
- Finish: 26' 1" after the metal "water" cover at the sidewalk for the section, "Garden of the Crucification"; or, 33' 3" before the sign for the "Office" in the same section.
