- Runners have access to the entire road surface to allow for the shortest distance,
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, yellow survey marker washers sprayed with yellow paint.
- It will be the responsibility of the race director to repaint the references each year.

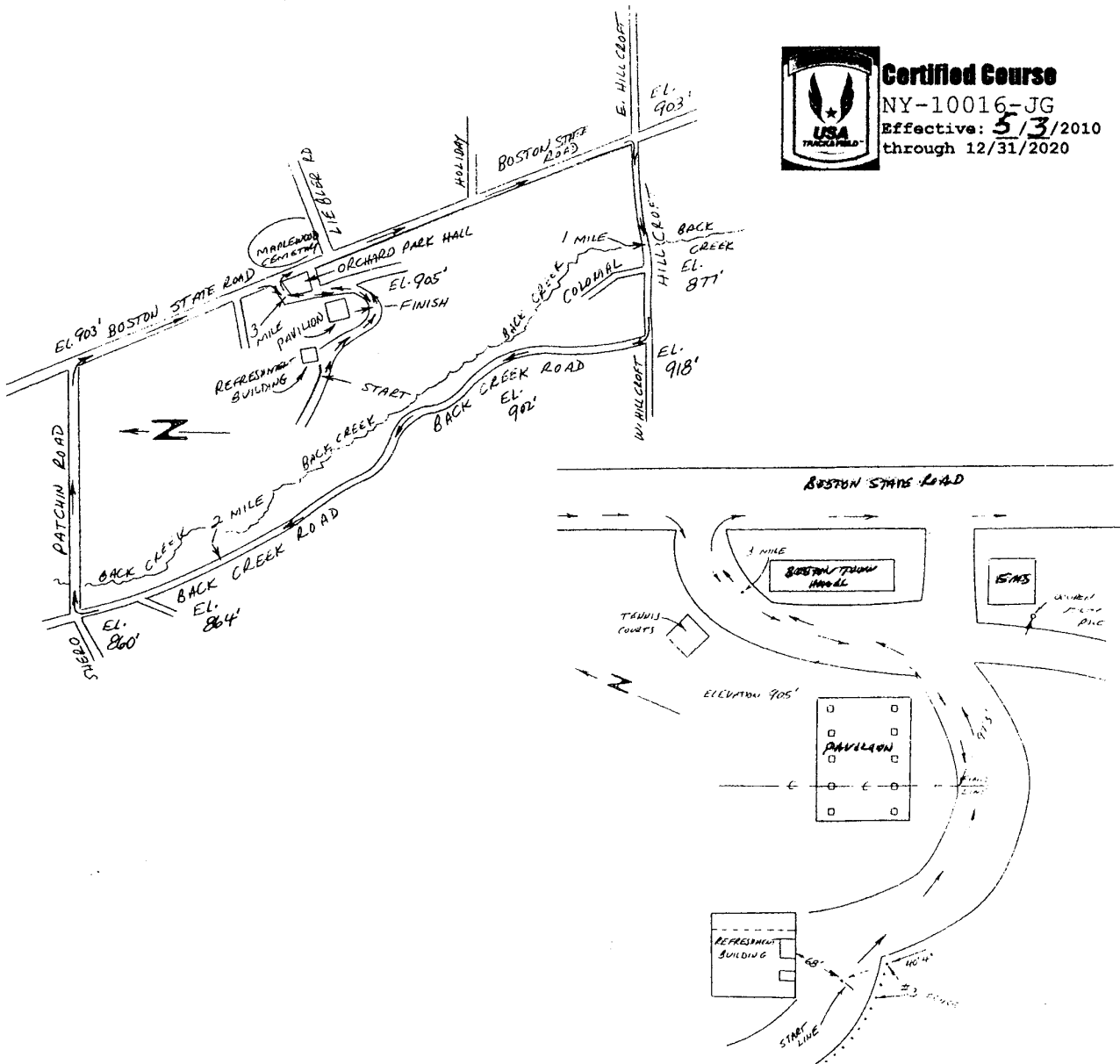
Start: 40' 4" from the end of the chain link fence # 3, near sign "Park Closed at Dusk; Park Closed Nov. 1 to March 31" & 68' 0" to the double doors of the refreshment building.

Mile 1: 15' 9" after start of metal bridge support over Back Creek on Hillcroft Drive.

Mile 2: 14' 7" before wooden utility pole # NYSEG 102, Verizon # 209 on Back Creek Road.

Mile 3: 29' 3" before black light pole holding sign "No Parking, Town of Boston Officials Only".

Finish: 97' 3" from wooden utility pole behind the EMS building. At the "centerline" of the 2nd last support columns of the pavilion.
