-All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, then sprayed with orange fluorescent paint.

START: On Elmwood Ave. directly in line with utility pole #971 (see map).

1-MILE: On Delaware Ave. 20 yards north of Potomac.

2-MILE: On Delaware Ave. 48 yards north of Hodge.

3-MILE: On Elmwood 26 yards north of Hodge.

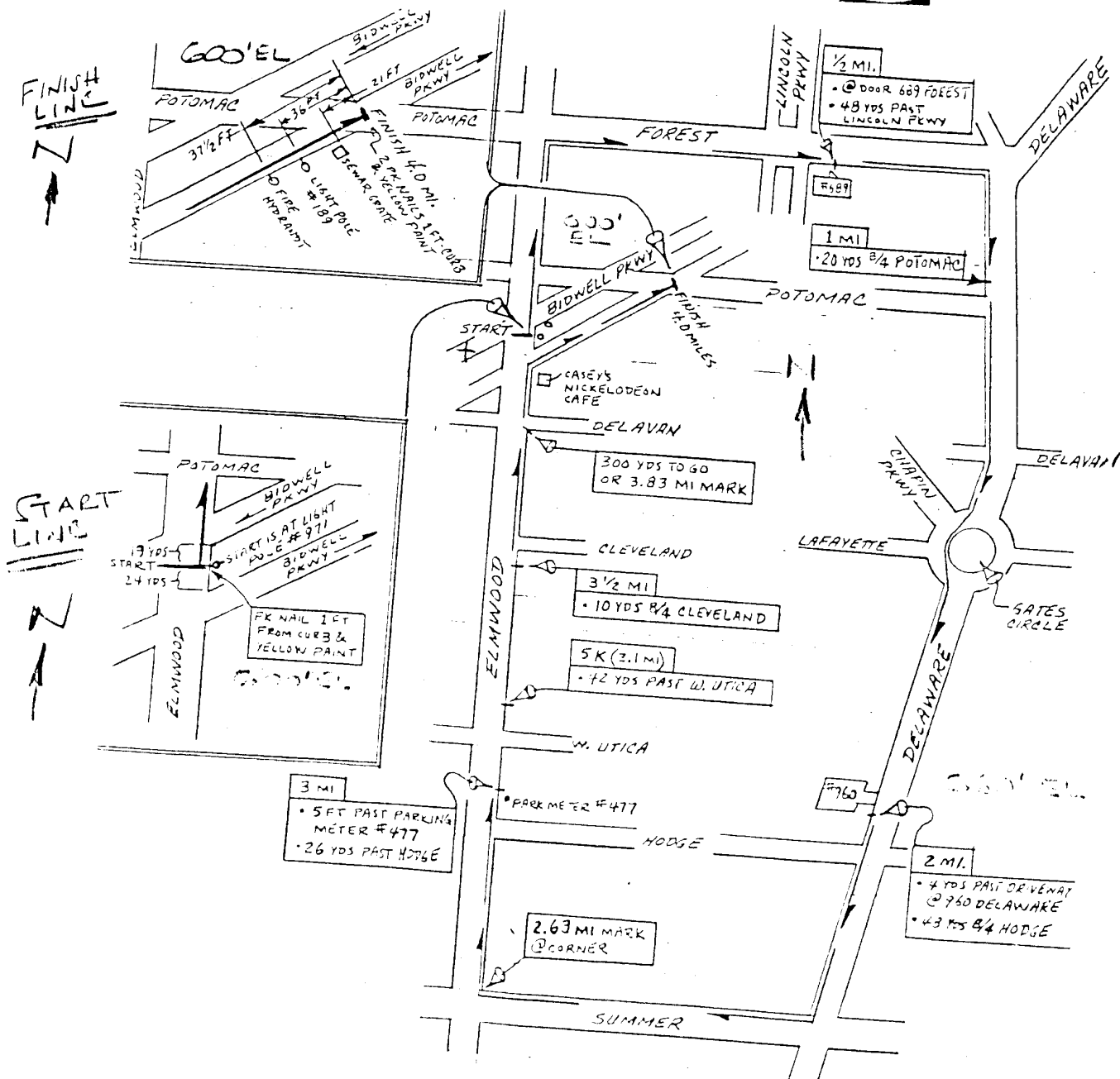
FINISH: On Bidwell Parkway 36 FT east of utility pole #189 (see map).
