- Erie Community College 330.03604 meter calibration course used
- Runners have access to the entire road surface to allow for the shortest distance,
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails with plastic yellow washers sprayed with white paint.
- It will be the responsibility of the race director to re-reference the references each year.

Start: 43' 4" before silver light pole # 20; or, 27' 7" before National Fuel Gas cover, both on South Park at back of First Niagara Center.

Mile 1: At black light pole # 2 on Perry at the corner of Commercial / Pearl and Perry.

Mile 2: 59' 4" before light pole # 24 in the Erie Basin Marina. Generally, between light poles # 22 and # 24.

Mile 3: 65' 2" after dark green light pole # 14 on Marine Drive.

5 Km: At center of metal sewer grate near the corner of cobblestone Commercial Street on Marine Drive ; or, 39' 7" after dark green light pole # 8 on Marine Drive..

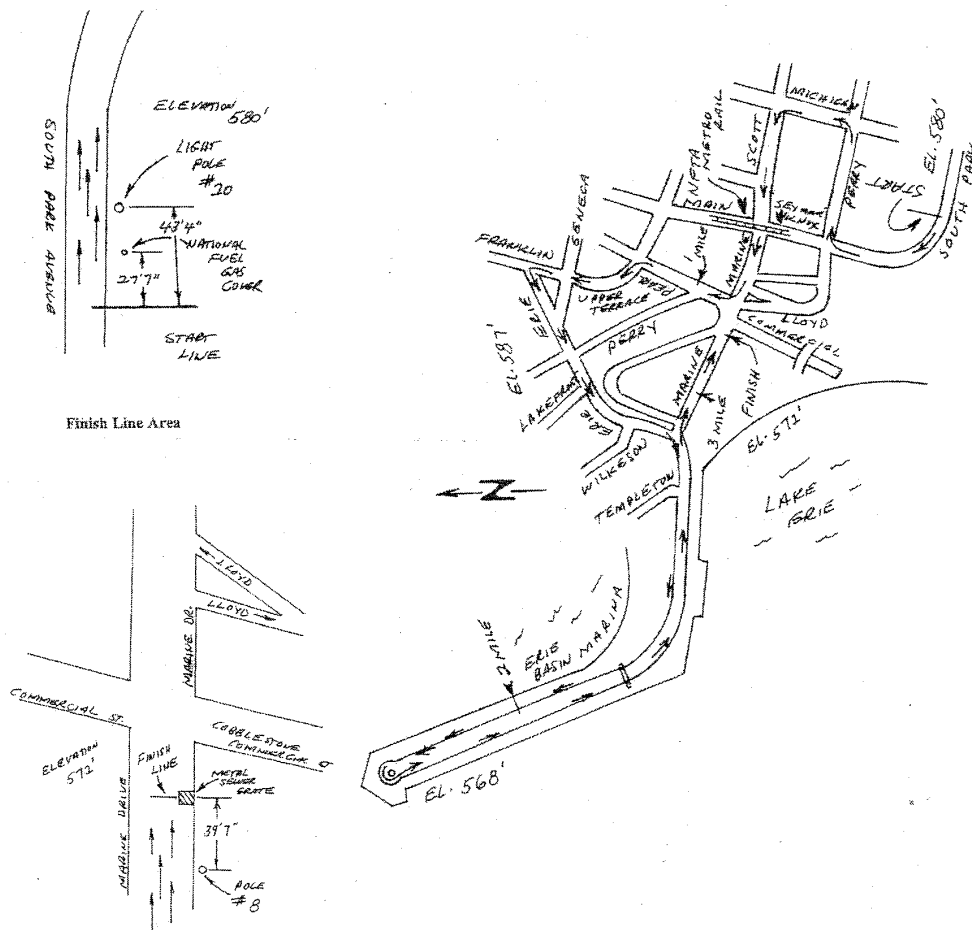
Start Line Area
