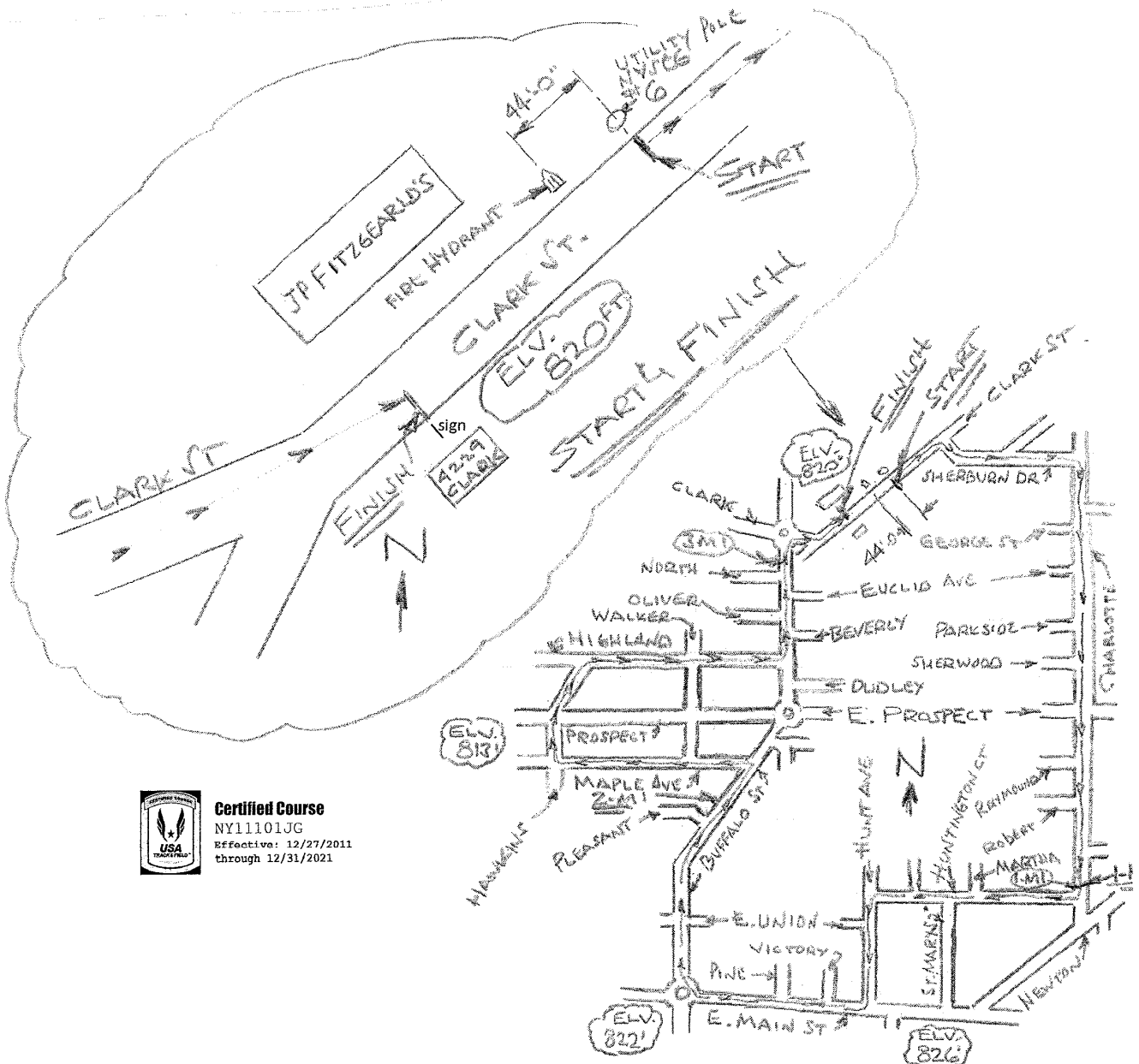


# RUN THE BURG FOR AUTISM 5-K HAMBURG, NEW YORK

Distance: 5K

- Erie Basin Marina 1000 foot calibration course used.
- Runners have access to entire road surface to allow shortest distance.
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, then sprayed with orange fluorescent paint.
- START: On Clark St. in line with utility pole NYSEG #6 and 44'0" N-E of fire hydrant (see map).
- 1-MILE: At intersection of Charlotte Ave. and Huntington Court.
- 2-MILE: In front of 140 Buffalo St.
- 3-MILE: At intersection of Buffalo St. and North St.
- FINISH: In front of 4229 Clark St. (see map). Even with sign for Tillou Veterinary Hospital.
