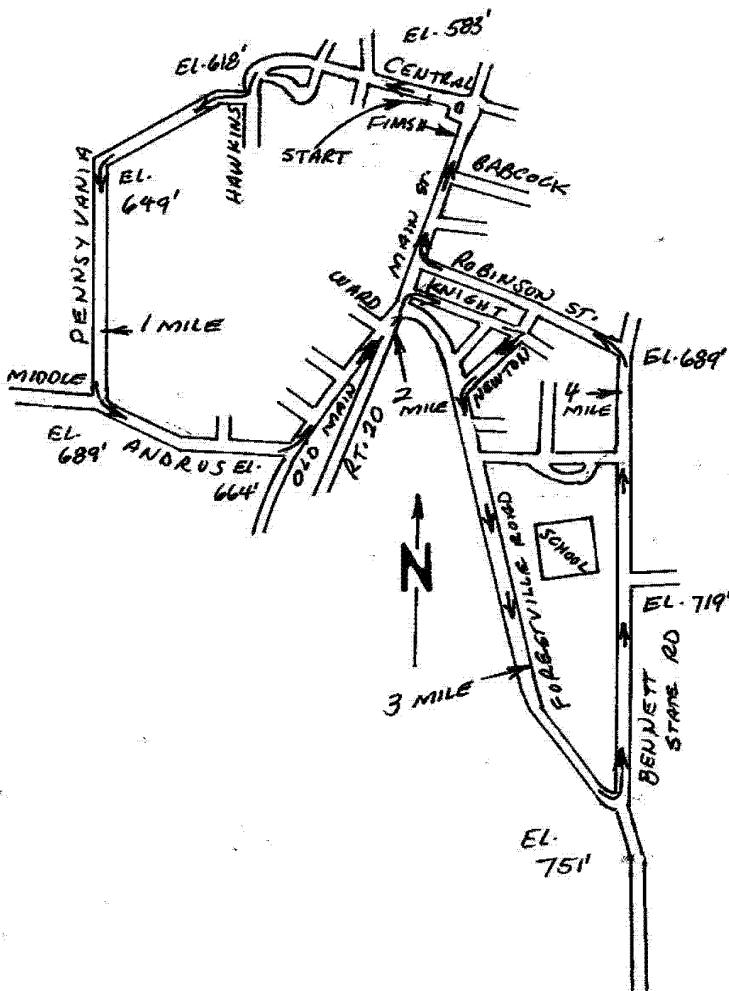

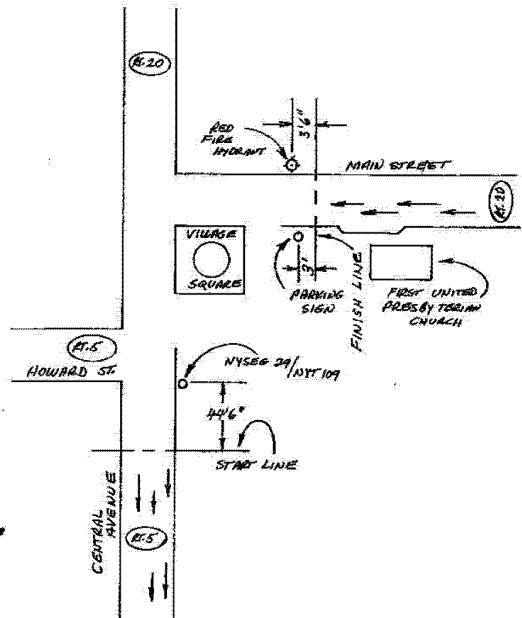

- Erie Community College 330.03604 meter calibration course used; NY11066JG
- Runners have access to the entire road surface to allow for the shortest distance,
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails with plastic yellow washers sprayed with yellow paint.
- It will be the responsibility of the race director to re-reference the references each year.

Start: 44' 6" after wooden utility pole # NYSEG 29, NYT 109 on Central Avenue, across from Howard Street.
Mile 1: 65' before wooden utility pole # NM 6 on Pennsylvania Ave.
Mile 2: 3' 6" past the center of storm sewer @ driveway to # 108 Main Street (Rt. 20).
Mile 3: 72' after wooden utility pole # NYSEG 1205 / 23 on Forestville Road.
Mile 4: 57' past wooden utility pole # NYSEG 13B, NYT #1 on Bennett State Road.
Finish: 3' 6" before "reserved parking" sign on Main Street; or, 3' 6" before red fire hydrant (on opposite side of street); at the side door of the First United Presbyterian Church.
