


# BUFFALO CITYBRATION 5-K BUFFALO, NEW YORK

- Erie Basin Marina 1000 foot calibration course used.
- Runners have access to entire road surface to allow shortest distance.
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, then sprayed with orange fluorescent paint.
- START: On Marine Dr. 16'7" east of center of Commercial Street. (see map).
- 1-MILE: On Ganson St. in line with pole #307.
- 2-MILE: On Ohio St. in line with pole #368.
- 3-MILE: On Marine Dr. across from Hanover Street.
- FINISH: On corner of Marine Dr. and Marine Dr. in line with stop sign (see map).
