

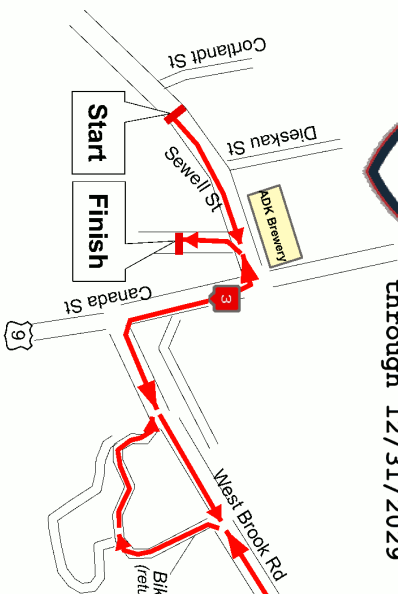

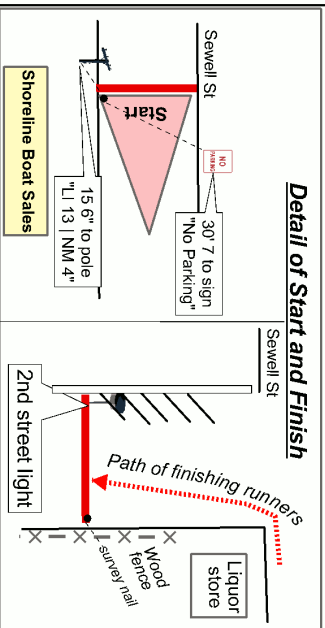

Detail of Start and Finish



Course Description. From the **Start** on Sewell St, the course proceeds east to **R** on Canada St, **L** on West Brook Rd (WBL), **R** on Beach Rd. Continuing on Beach Rd around the Million Dollar Beach parking lot to **M1**. It then turns **R** on E Shore Dr, **R** on Stanton to **M2**. Turning **R** on Fort George Rd, the course continues to **L** on Beach Rd, **L** on West Brook Rd (WBL), **L** on unnamed gravel foot path, looping **R** and returning to **L** onto West Brook Rd, **R** on Canada St to **M3**, then **L** on Sewell St, and **L** in unnamed drive behind liquor store to the **Finish**.

Key Points Description

Described as race is run

Start: On Sewell Rd at Shoreline Boat Sales. Point is 15' 6" (direct) from utility pole "LI 13 NM 4" on the S side and 30' 7" (direct) from "No Parking This Side" sign on N.

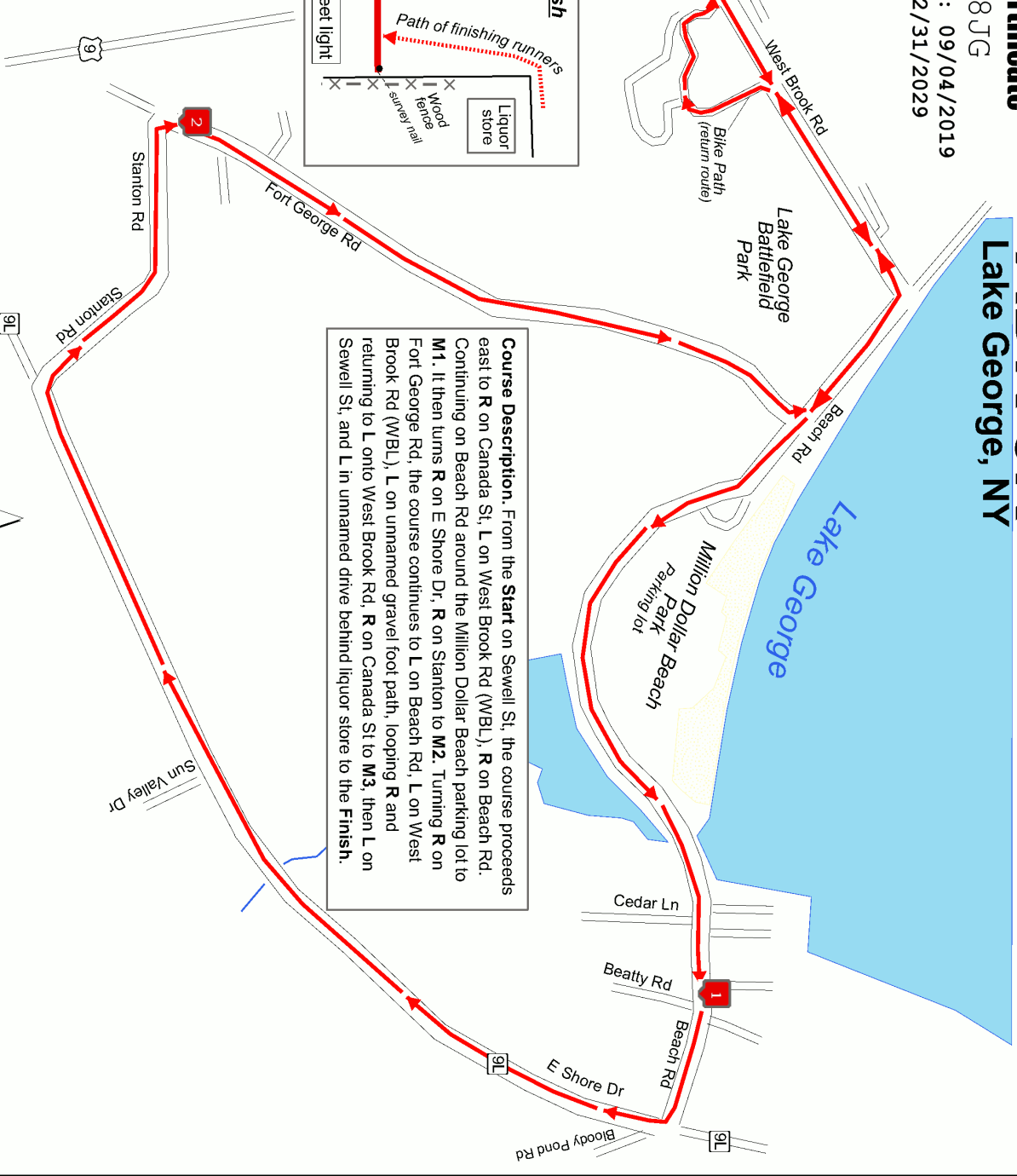
Mile 1: On Beach Rd at #202 after Cedar Ln. Point is 25' 3" after storm drain by Cedar Ln and 4' 0" before water main cap across from Prolyn Rd.

Mile 2: At #2 Stanton Rd before turn on to Fort George Rd. Point is even with utility pole "NM 2".

Mile 3: On Canada St (US 9) in front of Biscotti Bros. Cafe. Point is 26' 6" after storm drain by guard rail and 36' 2" before entry drive to cafe.

Finish: At 2" light pole on R in drive approx. 89' from Sewell. Point is even with base of pole.

All points marked with mag nail and yellow paint.
