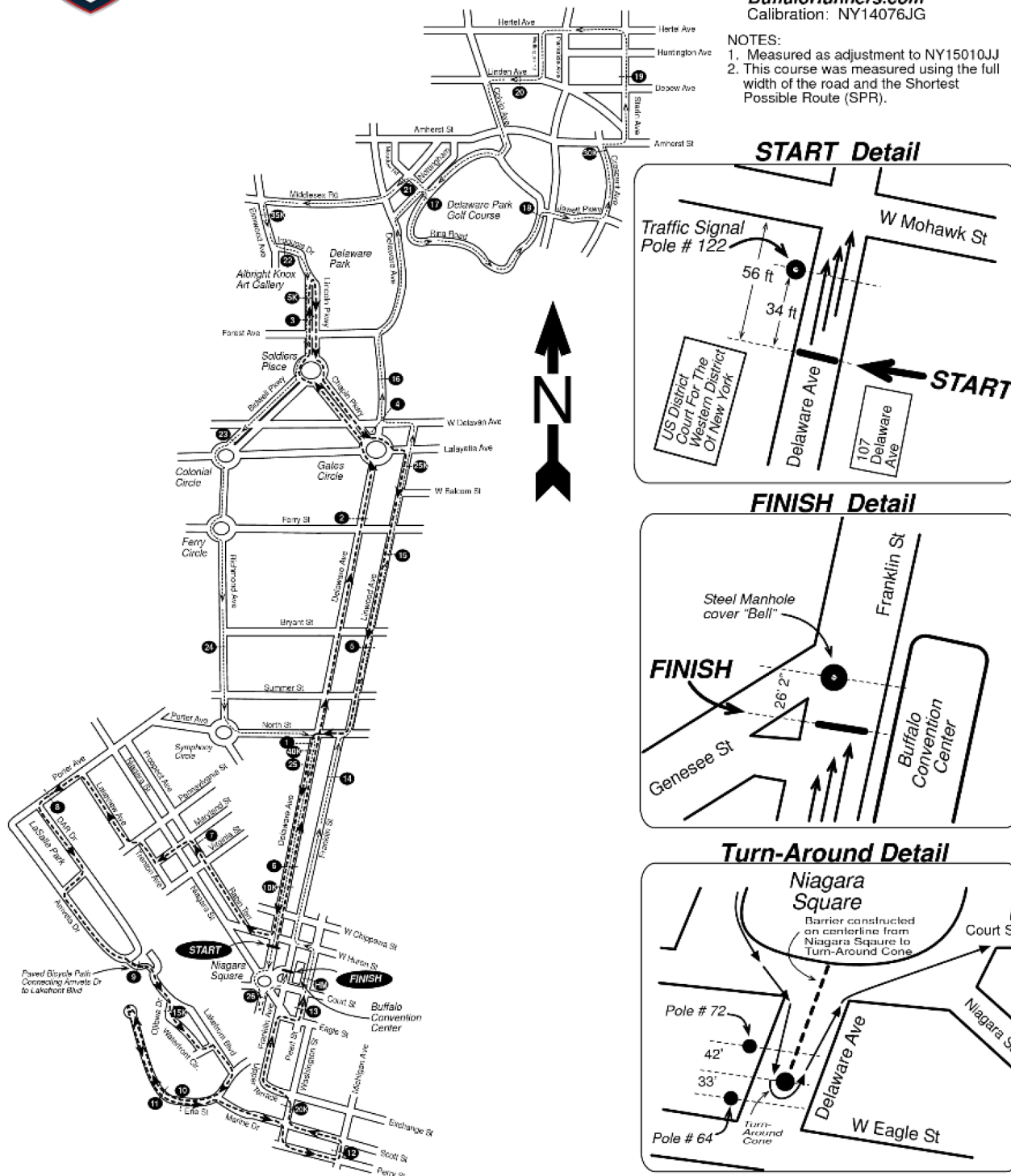

Buffalo Marathon 2020 Intermediate Splits

<i>Split</i>	<i>Location</i>
START	107 Delaware Ave, between W Mohawk St to the north and Niagara Square to the south, and 56 feet south of W Mohawk St, and 34 feet south of Traffic Signal Pole # 122 (located on the S-W corner of the intersection of W Mohawk St with Delaware Ave). Runners will start by running north from this location.
1 MILE	650 Delaware Ave (Walgreens Drug Store), 10 feet 6 inches past pole # 638, and generally past (north of) Allen St, and before North St.
2 MILE	1175 / 1180 Delaware Ave, just past W Ferry St and mid driveway at Canisius High School's Beecher Hall.
3 MILE	76 Lincoln Pkwy Service Rd, past (north of) Forest Ave, and 24 feet before (south of) black lamp pole # 76.
5K	140 Lincoln Pkwy Service Rd, past Rumsey Rd, 4 feet before (south of) black lamp pole # 126.
4 MILE	3 Chapin Pkwy, last house before (north of) Gates Circle, between sidewalk intersection and round manhole cover.
5 MILE	228 Linwood Ave, at south edge of driveway, just past Bryant St
6 MILE	414 Delaware Ave, 20 feet south of intersection with Edward St., 7 feet before pole # 418.
10K	306 Delaware Ave, and 19 feet before Lamp Pole # 302, and generally past Tracy St and before Johnson Park (N).
7 MILE	219 / 224 Prospect Ave, at north edge of driveway at 219 Prospect Ave, and generally past Virginia St and before Maryland St.
8 MILE	On the Porter Ave I-190 overpass directly above the RR track, between 4th St to the east and DAR Dr to the west.
9 MILE	On the Bike Path, 115' south of entrance from Amvets Dr and 21' north of sign post "DANGER UNDERCURRENT"
15K	Ojibwa Cir, just past Lakefront Blvd and 34' east of Pole # 21
10 MILE	on Erie St 80' west of Templeton Terr and at the "NO STANDING ANYTIME" sign
11 MILE	Erie St (Near the "Hatch") and 44' south of Pole # 12
12 MILE	On Michigan Ave 64' north of intersection with Perry St and 61' south of Pole # 144
20K	On Washington St between Exchange St and Scott St and 47' south of south edge of I-190 overpass
13 MILE	Pearl St, 5' past Pole # 196 which is right after the Eagle St intersection
Half Marathon	Pearl St, 82' past the intersection with Court St

16 MILE	On Delaware Ave 10' south of intersect with Inwood Pl
17 MILE	Delaware Park's Ring Road 9' past intersect with Meadow Rd
18 MILE	Mid curve of intersect of Ring Rd & Jewett Pkwy, 5' past STOP Sign
30K	Mid curve of intersection of Crescent Ave with Amherst St, and 12' before Pole # 1581
19 MILE	Starin Ave, 38' past intersection with Depew Ave
20 MILE	326/330 Linden Ave, 29' before Pole # 329, between Norwalk Ave and North Park Ave
21 MILE	62 Middlesex RD, 28' before Pole #64, just past the intersect with Meadow Rd
35K	Elmwood Ave, 78' past Pole # 1465, just past Middlesex Ave
22 MILE	On Iroquois Dr, 26' before Pole # 1329, just past Elmwood Ave
23 MILE	Near 48 Bidwell Pkwy, 19' before Pole # 40, and just past Delavan Ave
24 MILE	204 Richmond Ave, 46' before Pole # 169, between Connecticut St and 17th St.
40K	On Delaware Ave, 69' past Pole # 638 (at Roosevelt Inaugural Memorial) just south of North St
25 MILE	560 Delaware Ave, 36' north of Allen St.
26 MILE	On Delaware Ave south of Niagara Square, 10' past Pole # 88
Turn-Around	Delaware Ave between Niagara Square and W Eagle St, in the center of the road, and 33' north of Pole # 64 and 42' south of Pole # 72. Location is 62' north of W Eagle St and 229' south of Niagara Square
Marathon	On Franklin St at the Buffalo Convention Center, 153 Franklin St, and mid-island of Genesee St intersect and exactly 26' 2" south of the center of manhole cover "Bell" (the closest of 2 such covers), and 29' 9" before center doors Of the Buffalo Convention Center
