

Key Points Description
<i>Described as race is run</i>
Start/Finish: On Hermes Rd in the SBL (south bound lane). Point on south of line is at EOP (edge of pavement) 29'6" (direct) from LP (light pole) #50 and 41' 6" (direct) from LP #51. Point on north of line is at EOP, 44'7" (direct) from LP #50 and 54' 5" (direct) from LP #51.
Mile 1: On Rocket Way in NBL across from ball park. Point is 110'8" after storm drain and across from 14th post from S end of rail fence for ball park (marked with green/white "AFSCO" sign.)
Mile 2: At the southeast corner of entry drive around the Global Foundries lot and Saratoga Research Center Rd. Point is at stop line for entry drive on SE corner. No nail/marks.
Cone line (inbound runners only): At stop sign on Stonebreak Rd Ext at intersection with Stonebreak Rd Ext E. Points include: 1) at north end of centerline double yellow stripe; 2) at north corner of painted island; and 3) at west end of stop line for traffic continuing straight.
Mile 3: On Hermes Rd in NBL. Point is 13' 8" after diagonal seam (at EOP) across all lanes
<i>All points marked at EOP with green paint and survey nail thru pink tape, except M2.</i>



Course Description. The common **Start/Finish** is on Hermes Rd approximately 297' southeast of the entrance to Global Foundries office building. The 5K field starts in the south bound lane (SBL) and the course proceeds southeast, taking the second exit at traffic circle #1 with Stonebreak Rd Extension and continuing onto Rocket Way, **after which runners must keep the right of the centerline.** Proceeding to traffic circle #2 with Luther Forest Blvd, runners take the third exit looping back into the NBL of Rocket Way to **Mile 1**. Returning to traffic circle #1, the course takes the first exit onto Stonebreak Rd Extension and turning **R** at the stop sign the course continues to traffic circle #3 with Saratoga Research Center Rd, taking the second exit. Passing the security gate, runners take the first exit at traffic circle #4 onto the Global Foundries plant entrance drive to **Mile 2**. Continuing on the entrance drive the course loops left around the top of employee parking lot, then bears right at the main entrance to the plant, passing around the island under the canopy. The course then returns to Saratoga Research Center Rd, keeping left at the island (against traffic flow), and continues back to the traffic circle #4, taking the first exit, passing the security gate, and taking the first exit at the next traffic circle #3 onto Stonebreak Rd Extension. Approaching the stop sign runners **keep right of the cone line** and continue to a **L** turn onto Stonebreak Rd Extension back to the first exit on to Hermes Rd at the traffic circle #1 to **Mile 3** and then on to the **Start/Finish**.
