Run LoCo Half Marathon (Lenoir City, TN)

Measured 8/20/2023 using the full width of the road and the shortest possible route (SPR), except where

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START is at Tellico Dam Parking Area in the second parking lot on the north side of the access road to the main parking lot, in line with the line created by the edge of the asphalt and the grass.

- Leave the parking area and turn left on the access road and left on the road to Tellico Pkwy.
- Stay on the bike path/shoulder of Route 321 to Route 11/Lee Hwy/Broadway. Turn left, staying in the Cross Tellico Pkwy and stay straight onto the bike path/shoulder on the west side of Route 321
- St and Broadway. southernmost traffic lane of Broadway. Furnaround 1 is $11^\prime 10^\prime\prime$ east of the transition from brick pavers to concrete east of the intersection of A
- Return to Pike St, staying in the southernmost traffic lane of Broadway
- After entering intersection with Pike St, turn left, crossing all lanes of Broadway, and stay straight onto
- Stay on greenway to parking lot where greenway exits at Wilson St Turn right on Wilson St and right on Panther Dr.
- Turn left through gate and merge onto track. Follow track counterclockwise
- Exit far side of the track and stay straight through the parking lot.
- Turnaround 2 is the northern edge of the storm drain south of the intersection of Town Creek Pkwy Turn left on Harrison Ave and right on Town Creek Pkwy, staying in easternmost traffic lane.
- Return in easternmost traffic lane of Town Creek Pkwy.

- After entering intersection with Cotton Mill Blvd, turn right on Cotton Mill Blvd, staying right of the
- Turnaround 3 is the northern edge of the manhole cover at the north side of Cotton Mill Blvd (before
- in easternmost traffic lane of Town Creek Pkwy. Return to the track and follow track counterclockwise. Exit opposite side of the track through the gate. Return to Town Creek Pkwy staying right of the median and cross Town Creek Pkwy. Turn right, staying
- Return to the greenway and to Broadway/Pike St.

Cross Broadway in the Pike St intersection and turn left, staying in the southernmost traffic lane of

- Return to the Tellico Dam Parking Area, staying in the bike path/shoulder on the west side of Route
- At the first parking lot on the north side of the Tellico Dam access road, merge onto the dam path.
- Continue on the dam path toward Tellico Dam. Turnaround 4 is the last survey monument on the path
- Return to the parking lot at the end of the dam path, turn right on the access road, and right to the

FINISH is the same as START.
